## A Typical School Day

Reading Books and journals should be brought to school every day.

Spellings will be given out on Friday and tested the following Friday
Maths homework is usually set on a Friday to be returned on a Thursday.

Topic homework is set termly, and the children will bring home a homework grid.

## School Uniform

## English

$>$ Our focus for this year is to develop a powerful vocabulary of words to improve the level of writing.
$>$ SPaG is taught in class but there is no homework.
> Spellings are drawn from patterns and the Year 3 and 4 word list.
$>$ Ideally children should be reading every day at home.

## Maths

> Our focus is to embed the White Rose Maths strategies in children's learning.
> This scheme develops the Mastery Approach.
> We will be using TT Rockstars to support times tables. At the end of the year, all year 4 children will take part in the national times tables test.
