School Uniform

English

- Our focus for this year is to develop a powerful vocabulary of words to improve the level of writing.
- SPaG is taught in class but there is no homework.
- Spellings are drawn from patterns and the Year 3 and 4 word list.
- Ideally children should be reading every day at home.



Maths

- Our focus is to embed the White Rose Maths strategies in children's learning.
- **This scheme develops the Mastery Approach.**
- We will be using TT Rockstars to support times tables. At the end of the year, all year 4 children will take part in the national times tables test.




How can you help?

English

- Reading with your child (record in reading journals)
- Writing/spelling homework
- Word games
- Opportunities to write at home; letters, postcards etc

Maths

- Support homework
 - Practice times tables, up to 12x12
 - Help to tell the time on an analogue clock
 - Money
