

ENGLISH

We will develop our reading and writing skills by writing simple lists and stories. In Little Wandle we will rise to more challenging phonics and weekly spelling patterns. Try sharing some stories at home with your child.



MATHS

In Maths pupils will extend their knowledge of counting to at least 20 objects including estimating numbers and using this knowledge to solve problems. They will begin to relate addition to counting on. Encourage your child to count everyday objects around them.

SCIENCE

This unit will help pupils to understand why we need to eat food and how to make healthy choices. Pupils will be learning about different parts of their body and their senses.



GEOGRAPHY

In Geography we'll be finding out about our local town of Malmesbury.

Go for a walk around the town with your child and identify different buildings e.g. shops, cafes, offices.
