Literacy

- Continue Little Wandle Phonics.
- Join in with repeated refrains in stories and poems.
- Attempt to use descriptive language when storytelling.
- Begin to recognise familiar letters and words.
- Name practice.

Expressive arts and design

- Listen and join in with singing and new music
- Learn songs for the Nativity performance.
- Use our imagination in our play.
- Use mixed media, such as clay and natural materials to create art work for different purposes.

Our learning this term includes:

Numeracy

- Continue daily counting in 1s, 2s and 10s and enjoy number songs.
- Begin to recognise numerals beyond those of personal significance.
- Practise number formation.
- Identify and naming circles and triangles.
- Understanding preposition.

Communication and Language

- Take turns to listen and contribute ideas in discussions and play.
- Use appropriate language relating to our topic and learning.
- Respond appropriately to questions.

Physical Development

- Begin or continue to hold pencils correctly.
- Begin to form letter and numbers correctly.
- Develop balancing while stationary and on the move.
- To develop running and stopping.
- To develop changing direction.
- To develop jumping and landing.
- To explore different ways to travel.

Understanding the World

- Notice and talk about the changes in the environment.
- Understand that people may celebrate in different ways and why we celebrate.
- Talk about their own experiences of
- celebrations.
- Understand and discuss keeping safe.

Personal, social, emotional development

- Be aware and understand the needs of myself and others.
- Become increasingly confident in myself and take on new challenges.
- Begin to accept and adapt to the changes in routines of the day.

Home learning

Home learning is vital to help your child consolidate learning that has taken place in school so please work on your home packs and reading. Remember to make the learning fun and keep it short!
