<p>Write a letter to Brunel telling him about the old railway in Malmesbury.</p> <p>Do you have questions to ask him about his inventions?</p>	<p>With an adult, carry on our Entry Point walk by walking out under the by-pass towards the sewage works. See whether you can find any more railway remains - take photos if you do!</p>	<p>Visit the STEAM museum in Swindon. Bring in a photo/ evidence of your trip and get ready to tell us some facts!</p> <p>(This counts as <u>two</u> homeworks!)</p>
<p>Read a non-fiction (information) book linked to Brunel, ships, bridges or trains. Record five facts you have found out.</p>	<p>Create a profile of Isambard Kingdom Brunel. This should include a picture of him, information like his date of birth and other interesting facts.</p> <p>https://www.bbc.co.uk/teach/class-clips-video/true-stories-isambard-kingdom-brunel/zjrtvk7</p>	<p>Make or design an invention of your own!</p> <p>This could be related to travel or something completely new!</p>
<p>Make a model or painting of something Brunel made. Models could be made out of anything: Lego, Kinex, paper...</p>	<p>Maths!</p> <p>Find out about the size of Brunel's inventions.</p> <p>Create a table to order them from smallest/shortest to largest/longest.</p>	<p>Design or create a menu for the first and second class passengers on the SS Great Britain. Remember to think about what foods they would have eaten at that time.</p>
