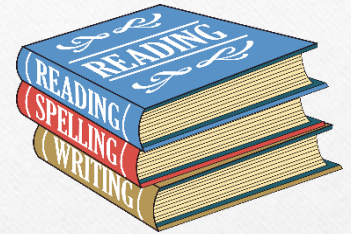

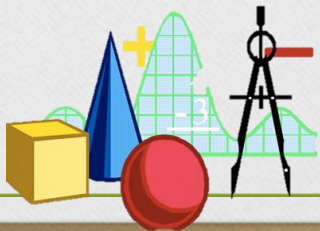

**P.E day:** Mondays and Wednesdays – Children to have their PE kit in school.

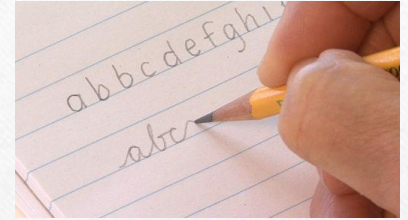
